Goose Van Schaick's Regt. and fought in the battle of Oriskany; about 1779 John was taken prisoner with others while on board a Man of War, which was cruising along the Canada shore and held in prison in the fall and winter of the same year and "in consequence of having been deprived of fire, he froze his feet". In 1790 John received bounty land, amounting to six hundred acres, located in the military tract of Romulus Twp., Onondaga Co., N.Y. (RWPA: #W25785)

House, Peter C., m. Anna Shaut, 1/11/1785, by Rev. Abraham Rosencrantz; d. 7/1/1813, Sacketts Harbor, N.Y. (Anna House, b. 1765/6; resident of Wheeler, Steuben Co., N.Y. on 7/10/1855.) Peter C. served first in the American Revolution as a private and corporal from 1779 through 1781 at various times under Cols. Clyde, Harper and Van Rensselaer. He volunteered for service again in the War of 1812 and was a private in Capt. David Moyer's Co., U.S. Volunteers; he enlisted on or about 2/8/1813 for one year and died on or about 7/1/1813 "by reason of wounds received or disease contracted in said service" at Sacketts Harbor.
