Dieffendorf, John, b. 5/10/1742, Minden, N.Y.; m. Catharine Hess, 4/19/1768, Stone Arabia; d. 7/26/1834, Minden, Montgomery Co., N.Y. (Catharine Dieffendorf, dau. of Augustinus Hess, b. 7/27/1748; d. 12/15/1838, Minden, N.Y.) Children: Gertrude (wife of [?] Dygert; resident of Minden, N.Y. in 1837). John enlisted in February 1776 and served as a private in Capt. Henry Diefendorf's Co., Col. Ebenezer Cox's 1st. Regt.; was in the battle of Oriskany where both Capt. Diefendorf and Col. Cox were killed; May 1778 enlisted for four months in Capt. Jacob Diefendorf's Co., Col. Clyde's 1st. Regt.; continued service in the same company and regiment through 1781. (RWPA: #W24061)
